## 2016-2017 Ski & Ride School Ability Levels & Details

Ski & Ride School Levels	Terrain Capability	Ability Description
<b>Orange (Level 1)</b>	1st Time Skiing or Riding	Never-ever skied or snowboarded before. Intro to equipment, basic balance & stance, learning to turn and stop.
<b>Red (Level 2)</b>	Ski or Ridden before but <b>not on a lift</b>	Had Lesson before, has not been on lift. Working on turns, working on stopping.
<b>Green (Level 3)</b>	Green slopes	Can stop, make wedge turns (ski), working on linking turns (snowboard). Ski without assistance, skier and snowboarders are developing turn shape.
<b>Green/Blue (Level 4)</b>	Green & Blue slopes	Controls speed through turns, skiers have round shape through turns, Snowboarders beginning to balance on edge. Skiers intro to poles, intro to trees, terrain park, and off-piste conditions. Snowboard intro to trees, terrain park, off piste conditions, and intro to switch.
<b>Blue (Level 5)</b>	Blue slopes	Skiers matching skis on easier blue terrain, snowboarders linking short and long turns. Skiers beginning to carve skis and snowboarders using feet & legs to steer while upper body remaining calm. Skiers using poles to compliment start of turn. Skiers and Snowboarders exploring bumps, trees, terrain park, off piste conditions. Skiers intro to switch skiing, snowboarders intro to half-pipe. Confident on blue runs and developing on black runs.
<b>Blue/Black (Level 6)</b>	Blue/Black slopes	Skiers matching skis on all blue terrain. Hockey stops in both directions. Further development into bumps, trees, terrain park, and off piste. Consistent complementary pole plant. Aggressive in control skiing. Snowboarders ride switch on blue terrain. Comfortable linking turns on black groomers. Further development into bumps, trees, terrain park, off-piste. Short carved turns. Knees flex & extend through turns, aggressive in control snowboarding.
<b>Black (Level 7)</b>	Black slopes	Skiers matching skis on black groomers, skis all conditions, on or off piste. Turning legs consistently under separate upper body. Snowboarders ride in all conditions, on or off piste, aggressive in bumps, trees, spinning off jumps in the park.

**Adult All Day Lessons** begin at 10:00 am. **Adult Half Day Lessons** (for first-timers only) begin at 9:30 am or at 1:00 pm.

**Youth Lessons** begin at 9:30 am. Check-in begins at 8:00 am. Parents have the option to pick up their children at 1:00 pm and *must* inform Ski & Ride School of their wish to do so while checking in their child the morning of the lesson; no change in price.
